



Proposal for a two week tour of the West Coast

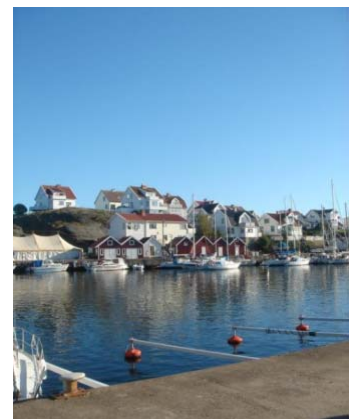
Our marina is located on Marstrand. When you are here, are you already in the archipelago. It begins just south of Gothenburg and continues up to the Norwegian border.



Day 1. Sunday

After having checked in and got to know the boat it is heading north out of the port of Marstrand.

Wait to set sail until you come out on the bay. When you feel you can boat takes you a trip to the Åstol, which lies just north of Marstrand. Åstol has a fine harbor, where it tends to add alongside the quay. Here is a nice fish restaurant at the harbor entrance.





Day 2. Monday

After a good breakfast so we recommend that you sail further north along the outside of the major islands and Tjörn Orust. Here lies the small fishing communities close and you can navigate their way between all the small islands along the fairway. The journey towards Gullholmen. Gullholmen is in many respects unique island dating from the 1200s. Have a nice lunch in Mollösunds protected port. Blow it a lot, so you can sail on the inside of Tjörn and Orust when you leave Åstol. The distance to Gull islands from Åstol is about 17 nm.

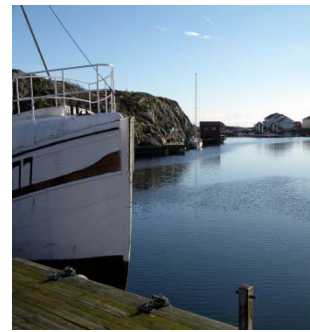

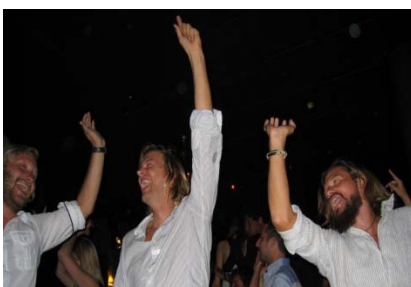
Day 12 and 13. Thursday through Friday
